On behalf of our millions of members and supporters, we write to request **NAME OF COMPANY's** position on the Trump administration's efforts to roll back vehicle fuel economy and greenhouse gas emissions standards (clean car standards) and revoke California's right under the Clean Air Act (along with that of 14 other states and the District of Columbia) to protect its people from tailpipe pollution.

Transportation is the leading source of carbon pollution in the nation, and the clean car standards are the best policy tool that you have to protect your customers and potential customers. Now -- as Trump is laying heavy pressure on automakers -- is the time for your company to speak out and declare its opposition to this administration's dangerous rollback.

Our organizations have supported strong clean car standards because we must protect our air, climate, and health, and we have concerns about U.S. oil dependency and the many problems that it creates. The auto industry negotiated the Obama standards and stood with him when he signed them.

And yet the auto industry also initiated this rollback, first with a petition signed days after the 2016 election and then in a meeting with President Trump just four days into the new administration. Trump has made it clear to automakers that it's his way or the highway when it comes to scrapping the clean car standards. Given the stakes for your customers' potential savings at the pump, U.S. oil dependency and the fate of the atmosphere, it is incumbent upon you to make it clear to the public: Do you support or oppose Trump's rollback?
