
Thank you for your letter and suggestions regarding updates to statewide energy codes for commercial and non-residential buildings, and for state-funded buildings.

The Comptroller's State Energy Conservation Office (SECO) has the authority to periodically review and update these codes, and with energy code legislation just acted upon by the 84th Texas Legislature, we are assessing the appropriate next steps.
