

The tour on the 2.25-mile boardwalk, in this 14,000 acre ancient cypress forest, takes you into a green and liquid world where at every turn you see scenes so beautiful they could have been arranged by the world's best floral designer. The Corkscrew trail, largely shady, features benches and rain shelters along the way. Bring your own lunch and drinks for a picnic outside afterwards, or purchase from a small café inside the center. Rated: Easy. Limit: 20.
