RE: Elcon's withdrawal of the permit applications

Elcon Recycling Services is announcing that it has decided not to proceed with its proposed project in Falls Township, Pennsylvania. The current business climate, including the impacts of COVID-19, has forced Elcon to re-evaluate its plans for expanding its hazardous waste treatment business into the United States. Elcon feels confident that it could obtain the approvals necessary to operate the proposed facility, and that the proposed facility would have provided an environmentally sustainable solution for treating liquid hazardous waste. Elcon very much appreciates the professionalism of everyone it has worked with at PADEP. The permitting process, however, is being terminated and Elcon will be notifying PADEP that it will be withdrawing the applications that are pending. It will also notify the Bucks County Court of Common Pleas that it is withdrawing its land use appeal. It is entirely possible that Elcon will seek to expand its treatment business into the U.S at some point in the future, especially if the U.S increases pharmaceutical manufacturing in response to COVID-19, with the corresponding need to increase the capacity for treating the liquid hazardous waste that is generated.
